


Master bedroom – moisture is likely in a solid state frozen in the wall – moisture meter reading is at maximum






Same Master bedroom window – opposite side



#### **CONCLUSION & COMMENTS**

Noreaster was called by XXXXXXXX for a service call to dry water damage February 17, 2015 but due to massive ongoing workload, Noreaster could not begin to field the assignment request until the evening of 2/19 after hours. We set one Revolution low grain refrigerant dehumidifier in the master bedroom into service – we were trying to be conservative to not use equipment when the loss is in a suspended state with outside temperatures at 6 degrees Fahrenheit at site arrival – therefore the fact that the Tramex Moisture Encounter read heavy extensive saturation makes us suspect that the water has changed its state to solid ice—Only the master bedroom had water running top to bottom on that particular window unit. THERE IS ACTIVE ICE DAM CAUSED WATER PENETRATION IN AT LEAST FOUR ROOMS TO DATE. RH 58% on arrival inside.

Owner advised that most snow was removed by XXXXXXX Contracting (Roofing) at least once.

We agreed to visit the site either Sunday 2/22 or Monday 2/23, or if the forecasted rain/snow/sleet begins to enter the rooms in mass prior.

INTERIM REPORT – THE INSURED'S INSURANCE ADJUSTER has a field inspection set for 2/21/15 that no Noreaster Disaster Restoration can attend, but the morning forecast on 2/21 is for below 0 Fahrenheit until late morning in Northern RI.

### SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT 2/27/2015\*\*\*\*\*

Images 17 & 18 were taken during the dryout of the master bed and bath. 19 & 20 were the other bedroom two days later. This home's other rooms in the interior of the appeared to be dry. We are removing drying gear on Saturday 2/28/2015. The Garage should have some drywall removed to facilitate ambient drying, and a drywall repair there would be less expensive than heat boosted drying in that location during extremely cold temperatures.
